Renowned Walla Walla artist Robert Kleinboonschate has lived in Australia since 1971. Robert has been particularly inspired by the philosophy and art of the Indigenous Peoples of Australia after living and working in Alice Springs and the surrounding region. With an impressive body of work and many years of experience as an artist and art instructor Robert will mentor workshop participants in the art of botanical painting for **intermediate/practicing artists**.

In this botanical painting workshop Robert will teach subject selection, composition, viewfinder use, subject placement, positive/negative shapes, colour mixing, wet on wet, wet on dry and wet on tacky painting, scumbling and glazing.

Attendees will learn to use and gain expertise with tools such as the charcoal brush and pallet knife and learn to use materials with confidence.
